

# Pocket Chart Onset Cards

Use these letter cards when doing word work at the pocket chart (a table top or floor space will also work).

## How to Use:

- \*Pick a word family rime (such as -at, -one, -uke, or -y)
- \*Write that same rime on individual index cards (10 times or so) and place them face up in the work space.
- \*Pick a few onsets from the set in this download to create real or silly words (For example, bat, jat, flat, grat, that, etc.) by adding the onset to the front of the rime.
- \*Read back through your words, indentifying the real and silly words.
- \***Extension:** Students can write the individual words down in a word study journal, write a sentence with some of the words, or a story.

## Vocabulary:

**Blend** - two letters, put together, and you hear both sounds (pp. 2-4)

**Digraph** - two letters, put together to make a single sound

Print onto cardstock and laminate for durability.
